Conference Site

The conference is being held at the Bell Harbor International Conference Center in Seattle, Washington. The Bell Harbor is located on the Bell Street Pier, the highlight of Seattle's waterfront and within walking distance of the heart of downtown.

Free transportation between the conference hotel and the Bell Harbor will be offered each day of the conference. Details on shuttle times and locations will be available upon check-in.

Seattle-Tacoma International Airport

Shuttles and buses run almost continuously around the clock, with scheduled departure and arrival times. The Ground Transportation Information Booth is located on the third floor of the Parking Garage.
